That is next Friday. The purpose for that day is going to be to provide the Appropriations Committee a full day for public hearings and agency hearings on the budget situation, and what their recommendation. As you know, they have to have the bill on the floor on the fortieth day. Given the magnitude of what they're facing, I think it's appropriate to give them an entire day to do their work. This will necessitate us renumbering the legislative days following March 8th, so Monday, the 11th, will become the thirty-seventh day. And I'm also going to set the last days of the session. If you see the calendar, the sixtieth day has not been set. I'm going to set the sixtieth day on that Friday, April 19th. So Thursday, the 18th, would be the fifty-ninth day, et cetera, working back. I'm going to put a new revised calendar out. It'll be in your offices, it'll be on the web site, it'll be posted on the UniNet. I'm going to do a public press release as well. But, so Friday, March 8th, just add that as a recess day. We'll make that up at the end of session. And session, we'll still be out on Friday, the 19th, unless you vote to do otherwise. I'm sure you are. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, General Affairs Committee reports LB 1135 as indefinitely postponed. I have amendments by Senator Bourne to LB 825. Senator Price offers LR 300; that will be laid over. Senator Bruning would like to add his name to LB 584. (Legislative Journal pages 747-750.)

Mr. President, a priority motion: Senator Janssen would move to adjourn until Wednesday, February 27, at 9:00 a.m.
