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occasion to do some instructing, and a hardheaded, stiff-necked child is difficult to instruct and the child often resents the instruction. But I do not believe in, never have believed in, never will believe in corporal punishment as a means to make somebody learn. But I believe in other coercive tactics, those which will make a person, before making a foolish decision the next time, consider is that which I will lose greater than that which I will win. And if it is, then I shall not do it. And if, after that analysis, the person does it again, then the lesson has to be taught again, not through cruelty. If cruelty is the means by which a lesson is taught, as soon as the cruel action, whatever it is, is removed, the conduct which was to be corrected reasserts itself. So people have to be persuaded. You persuade people to continue doing good things by praising them when they have made progress. You deter them from doing bad things by criticizing, by evaluating, and pointing out the consequences. So what are the consequences involved in that last vote? You are enjoying some of them now. I ought to go ahead and take a vote on my kill motion because I can offer a kill motion maybe next week. You can't offer it twice in the same day, but if I can stretch this out for three more days, I can put a kill motion on the bill each day and show you how much time can be taken on an A bill. And maybe that is just what I will do, but I will promise you that is not what I'm going to do. I'm not going to try to hold us on this bill for three days because time is becoming very valuable.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And we will just have to see how much time the body is willing to put on an A bill that will follow a bill that's going nowhere. What have you all done? (Laugh) Senator Vrtiska, what have you and your colleagues wrought? What have you done? Well, it doesn't matter because you've got a long weekend to think about it. You cannot do...undo what's been done. If a bill fails to advance on General File, you cannot consider the failure to advance, but if it does advance, you can reconsider the advancement, if you all want to do that, but you probably don't. So you're just going to have to stay with me and let me work my will on the Legislature, but I would remind you, under your new rules, you can move for cloture whenever you
