SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Suttle, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR SUTTLE: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This is just an amendment that changes the word "amendment" to "waiver." And this is in order to have the department ask for a waiver instead of an amendment to receiving money from the federal government for substance abuse therapy. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the adoption of the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Suttle, you're recognized to close. She waives that opportunity. The question before the body is the adoption of the amendment to LB 21. All in favor vote aye; all opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Suttle's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Erdman, you're recognized for a motion to advance.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I move the advancement of LB 21 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The question before the body is the advancement of the bill. All in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. It advances. LB 21A.

CLERK: LB 21A, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all, Senator. (AM7158, Legislative Journal page 443.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Erdman, you're recognized for a motion to adopt those amendments.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R
