CLERK: Senator Janssen would move to amend the amendment with AM3014. (Legislative Journal pages 824-825.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Janssen, you're recognized to open on that amendment.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. It changes language in the amendment regarding the sending of a notice in the case of cease and desist and denials of license to clarify that the notice must be sent by certified mail and the date of the notice is mailed. It is deemed to be the date of the service. That is a small change and it...it took care of a couple of questions that Senator Beutler had had. With that, I'd ask for the adoption of the amendment to AM2749.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the amendment to the amendment? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I wonder if Senator Janssen would yield to a question. Senator Janssen, I was occupied when you were giving your rundown on the part that you're going to amend. Could you run through that again, please?

SENATOR JANSSEN: On the amendment we're on, right, to the amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, what you were saying the first time. Could you go over that again?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Certainly, if you'd like to listen to that, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh) No thank you. I was just trying to show what a good person you are. But this bill does not in any way expand this kind of activity. It's more regulatory than anything else.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Right,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.
