SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Senator Wickersham, there are no further lights. Did you wish to close on your amendment? Senator Wickersham waives his option to close. The question before the body is adoption of AM2781 to the committee amendments to LB 1003. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the Wickersham amendment to the committee amendments. Have you all voted who care to? The Wickersham amendment to the committee amendments. Have you all voted who care? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wickersham's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Wickersham amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, new resolution, LR 303, by Senator Dierks, congratulating the members of the Chambers girls' basketball team; an amendment to be printed by Senator Bruning to LB 298, Senator Brashear to LB 876. (Legislative Journal pages 842-843.)

Mr. President, Senator Kristensen would move to recess until 1:30 p.m.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Speaker, you're recognized to speak.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. Members, I wanted to give you some idea of what we would be doing the rest of this week. This evening I would envision, or this afternoon, that we would go into late afternoon today. Tomorrow we will break for noon and then come back.
