SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chambers. Our chaplain this morning is Pastor J.J. White from the Berean Church in Lexington, and that happens to be Senator Jim Cudaback's district.

PASTOR WHITE: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you very much, Pastor White, for being with us. We appreciate it. I call the thirty-sixth day, the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please check in. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, just one item. Two reports have been received in the Clerk's Office, available for member review; one from the Health and Human Services System and one from the Property Assessment and Taxation Redevelopment Project. That will...that's all that I have at this time, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal page 861.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We now go to General File, 2002 committee priority bills. Mr. Clerk, first item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1003, a bill Senator Schrock. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January of this year, referred to the Natural Resources Committee. Yesterday, Mr. President, the committee amendments were offered. There was an amendment to the committee amendments by Senator Wickersham that...that prevailed. Mr. President, I now have a series of amendments to the committee amendments. The first is by Senator Schrock. Senator, I have a note you would like to withdraw AM2806 and offer, as a substitute, AM3032.
