RECESS

SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good afternoon. Senators, the Legislature is about to reconvene. Please check in. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any items for the record?

CLERK: Just one, Mr. President, LR 306, a new resolution by Senator Vrtiska, congratulating Nemaha Valley High School Girls...High School Academic Decathlon Team from Cook, Nebraska. That will be laid over. (Legislative Journal page 876.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: And a reminder, Mr. President, Transportation will have an Executive Session at two o'clock in Room 2022. That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is one-thirty. As the agenda says, General File, 2002 senator priority bills, Mr. Clerk, first item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1089, a bill introduced by Senator Landis. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 15, referred to the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I do...I have no committee amendments, Mr. President. I do have other amendments pending to the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Landis, you're recognized to open on LB 1089.
