SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I ultimately will withdraw this motion, but I need time to try to get some amendments because I have been summarily dismissed from this bill by Senator Beutler saying that all the important amendments have been incorporated into this amendment. I don't agree with that. And because, as Senator Beutler pointed out, people can make decisions about which amendments are important, that's what I have to do in my interests. I don't like the fees. I had said I'd go along with an eighth commissioner, but that's not going to be the case now. I'm going to fight every aspect of this bill. But before I do that, I'm going to divide the question. I'm going to divide it so that Senator Dierks' part about coming on the land is taken separately, because I agree with that and I have an amendment I want to put on that. And Senator... just to give you kind of an idea and you can be looking at what I will be dealing with in the division, they have a provision that deals with the fees. So what I would do is let everything relative to the eighth commissioner and any little odds and ends of the bill be taken with that. I would have Senator Dierks' provision be another division. Then the part that deals with the fees I would have as a third division. Now, if you look at your gadget you see that I have a lot of amendments up there. I'm as serious as a heart attack about all of them, and I know that cloture can be moved at any point. I know they're trying to put enough in this bill so they can get cloture. But if Game and Parks, with their expensive maps, with the big shots on the commission, with the attempt to extort money from many city people who go to some of these parks to underwrite the cost of parks that are not visited very much, if you're going to accept the insulting rationale by the spokesperson for Game and Parks for these fees, which is that's the cost of doing business, you all will accept it but I won't. I'm willing to take the session on this bill. So, after you get cloture today, because that's what you're going to have to do and you're going to have to do it with only an hour and a half of discussion on all of it, then you're going to have to do it on Select File after you get through cloturing me on some of the bills in front of it. You want Game and Parks that much? You think Game and Parks is that important? I think stopping those
