order, all they have to do is file six months ahead of time or a year ahead of time and they cannot be touched because the word will not get out that they have filed, and after 20 days it's all over. So this is an attempt to give citizens a chance to deal with the announcements that are typically made at the filing deadline, and I support it in the bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Other debate on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Schimek, you're recognized to close on the committee amendment. She waives that opportunity. The question before the body is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. We are voting on the committee amendments. Have you all voted who care to? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Those amendments are adopted. We're now debating the advancement of the bill. Senator Schimek, you're recognized to close on the advancement of the bill. She waives that opportunity. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 1054. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1054.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill advances. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, back to LB 1073. When the Legislature left the bill a short time ago, Senator Dwite Pedersen had pending an amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Is anyone authorized to handle Senator Pedersen's amendment? Mr. Clerk, pass over that amendment. Next amendment.
