CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The house is under call. Would all unexcused members please return to the Chamber and record their presence. The house is under call. Senator Kruse, Senator Bruning, Senator Brown, Senator Cunningham. Senator Burling, would you check in, please? Thank you. Senator Jones, the house is under call. Senator Brown, would you check in, please? Thank you. Senator Jones, Senator Bruning, Senator Kruse. Senator Bruning, the house is under call. First motion is the...or the first vote is the motion to bracket the bill until April 10th. All in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote no. Senator Chambers, did you ask for a roll call vote?

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 987.) 1 aye, 43 nays on the motion to bracket, Mr. President.
