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have any questions, I'm prepared to answer them.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. President and members. I will accept the amendment as offered now and clarified by Senator Chambers. I was concerned about the rest of the amendment as is implied. I have less concern about the word "only" but I...as I read it, it will now say "money in the fund may be spent for" so it does provide fairly serious guidelines. I think that DEQ would be confined to what is listed. I accept that in a sense then "only" perhaps is superfluous, and I...so I, in the name of simplicity, I will support the amendment and, as my understanding continues to be, that the rest of the Section 7 or all of Section 7 is intact as proposed in the committee amendments except for the change in the word "only". And with that understanding, I accept his amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to close on your amendment. He waives that opportunity. The question before the body is the adoption of the amendment to the amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: That amendment is adopted. Next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have, Senator Chambers, FA928.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, as I stated on the preceding amendment, I can read the writing on the wall. I am going to withdraw, at an appropriate time, this amendment, and I think that appropriate time is now. So I want to withdraw the pending amendment before us at this time.
