

TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATURE
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March 21, 2002 LB 946

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: I...I'm sorry, Mr. President. I'm trying to catch up here, but it is not necessary for us to give any serious consideration to...I don't even see that up on the board now. What are we doing? Thank you. That's what's confusing to me. I'm...I'm...I could...do you know why I'm confused, Senator Chambers? (laugh)

SENATOR CUDABACK: You're opening on...you're opening on the committee amendment, Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: All right. Thank you, Mr. President. I do not think that we need...I think the most...the most prudent thing for us to do at the moment, Mr. President, is not to discuss the committee amendments in any substance, but simply suggest that you vote no on the committee amendments so we can get to the subsequent material amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Any discussion? Discussion on the committee amendments? There were three lights on. Open for discussion. Senator Brashear. Senator Brashear waives off. Senator Brown, she waives off. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I have to try to get my bearings on this bill if I can. Senator Wickersham...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Don't ask me. (Laughter)

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. (Laughter)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. Any further discussion before we lose our place? Senator, do you wish to close on the committee amendments? He waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of the committee amendments to LB 946. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 1 aye, 20 nays on committee amendments, Mr. President.
