self-inflicted wound to our own character, our own credibility, our own integrity when it comes to making agreements. This is a matter of trust. And I respectfully suggest we ought not breach it. In other opportunities to speak with you, I intend to talk about what's been accomplished in terms of what we call the gee-whiz facts or statistically, and we certainly have to address the very, very serious questions of law that are involved here. Thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN PRESIDING

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you. Senator Brown to speak to the Brashear motion.

SENATOR BROWN: Mr. President, I would yield my time to Senator Brashear.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Brashear, you have five minutes.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. Chairman, members of the body. I know that opinions vary, but I want to respectfully suggest that LB 775 has been a great success, and we ought to call it that, and rejoice and be glad in it; 352 active projects, 168 pending applications, 26 completed projects, \$15 billion in qualified investment, 71,460 new jobs, and I think the most misunderstood aspect of the entirety of it, not projects in one or two counties, not projects in one or two areas; projects in 59 counties. LB 775 investment has been greatly diversified. It is not in any one area. We've had \$2.9 billion in publishing, communications, information, and data processing. We've had \$2.5 billion in railroads, trucking, air transportation, and warehousing. We've had \$2.5 billion in banking, securities, and insurance. We've had \$2.3 billion in food and meat products. We've had \$1.6 billion in printing, paper, chemical, plastics, rubber, and other nondurable manufacturing, and we've had \$1.5 billion in machinery, electronic, computer, and other kinds of manufacturing. Those are the investments. Those are the hard dollar investments. There has been a very, very significant diversity to the jobs that we have created under the applications that have been filed, and the contracts that were executed for the projects
