SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Fifteen minutes has expired. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 649. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Senator Chambers, for what point do you rise?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'd like a call of the house and roll call vote in reverse order.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: There's been a request to place the house under call. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays, to place the house under call.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The house is under call. Would all members return to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. We're looking for Senator Coordsen, Senator Dierks, Senator Jones, Senator Bromm, Senator Landis, Senator Cudaback, Senator Stuhr, Senators Brown, Engel, and Robak. Senator Engel, Senator Brown, Senator Robak. Senator Dierks. Senator Robak. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 649. There's been a request by Senator Chambers for a reverse order roll call. Members, please hold your conversations to a minimum so the Clerk can hear the roll. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1130.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 649.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill advances. I raise the call. LB 178.

CLERK: LB 178 by Senator Bourne. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 4 of last year; referred to Transportation; advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President. (AM0847, Legislative Journal page 1002, First Session, 2001.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bourne, you're recognized to open
