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payments, or because it's a fair fee for the...for the work done, or what's the basis upon which you think the fee should be paid?

SENATOR CONNEALY: Because of a court order.

SENATOR BROMM: Okay. Thank you. And I think between now and Select File, with a little bit of more research, unless someone's done it and I...I don't know it or haven't heard it, perhaps we can research a little bit further about how binding that order is on the state of Nebraska. I know that the judges have the authority and the jurisdiction to set fees and award attorney fees in certain cases, but if this is a state responsibility and that's why we're paying the attorneys to do so, I question somewhat the authority of the court to award a standard fee obligating the state in that respect, and I would like to...I'd like to do just a little bit more research on that. And I think it's terrible unfortunate that...that we have such a standard fee in this kind of an appeal. I think it discourages us from using this..this law. This law probably has some merit. I mean, the ALR process could be a good one, but I think it's becoming a travesty the way it's being handled. Senator Kristensen has a bill that's been on General File since last year which would reduce the costs a little bit for hearings at the initial level held by DMV, allowing them to be held telephonically and which would save some cost and some mileage and some expense, and I think we ought to do that. And then I think we've got to figure out another process for handling these appeals. And I hear what Senator Wehrbein is saying and it's a tough...a tough thing to figure out, but I think we ought to attempt to deal with this question of these payments between now and Select, but I don't want to hold up this bill. I'd like to see it go to Select File; see the amendment adopted and move the bill. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Dwite Pedersen.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Members of the Legislature, I'll try to be short. It was over a week ago, just about a week ago, when I was up here talking, mentioned that the automatic license revocation is a program that's not working.
