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We have a whole morning of evidence that that is not working. My guess, it costs us, costs the state far over a million dollars. Department of Motor Vehicles says it only costs somewhere in the neighborhood of seven hundred to eight hundred thousand dollars a year, and that's not counting the money we're talking about here. Is that right, Senator Connealy? Could you answer a question, please?

SENATOR CONNEALY: Yes.

SENATOR DW. PEDERSEN: The money we're talking about here has nothing to do with the money that Department of Motor Vehicles is spending for ALR. Is that right?

SENATOR CONNEALY: That's right.

SENATOR DW. PEDERSEN: Okay. So this...this is just over and above that, so I know that it's going to hit a million dollars or more for ALR, and I can tell you people ALR is not working. When we have a session that we're having when we need to find dollars and really need to cut dollars, this is where we need to go back to the bureaucrats and say, look up the programs you have that are not working and cut them, or that are doing nothing and cut them, or take a look at administration and cut them. I'm resolved to the fact that we are not really cutting anybody. We come and we say, you take a certain percentage and you take a certain percentage, and they take a program that the people like or that's doing something for the people and they cut that and make us scream. It's easy for them to come and ask for millions and twenty millions and ten million at a time, but when we cut them one million they scream like somebody stepped on their toe. We need to take a look at what is not working. Senator Thompson has taken a look at programs. I think we need to do more of that, that we've put in, in the last ten years that I've been in the Legislature, and at least the last five years, and say let's start doing some cutting of programs that don't work and don't do anything, instead of just hitting these percentages. This money is over and above what the Department of Motor Vehicles is spending for ALR. And you ought...the original purpose of ALR was a good purpose, but it's not working. There are sheriffs and chief of police people out
