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SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you. I heard just the tail end of what you were discussing with Senator Chambers and you had indicated that there was an agreement to take, if this reconsideration motion...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: I'm...I'm only speaking for myself.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay, so there is...so, as far as you know, if we consider this, the amendment that was adopted will stand and that will be 30 cents into the Reserve Fund, or what is your understanding?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: No. Okay, Senator Jensen is the primary sponsor on an amendment which I have cosigned which would, out of the 30 cents, take 15 and use that for General Fund purposes for two years. Two cents would go to 309 and at the end of the...that's ongoing, I think, for...till 2016 if it's drafted properly, and then at the end of the two years the 30 cents goes to the Health Care Trust (sic--Cash) Fund, but during...also during the two-year period 13 cents goes to the Cash Reserve. Thirteen cents to the Cash Reserve for two years, 15 cents to the General Fund for two years, 2 cents to 309 ongoing I think until 2016, and at the end of two years 30 cents would go into the Health Care Trust (sic--Cash) Fund, if I...if I've got the name of that fund right.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. What amendment is that, Senator?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: It should be on your machine now. It would be amendment...

SENATOR BOURNE: AM3325?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: I don't know the number.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay.
