SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. That's fair enough. And that's all I will ask you. Thank you. Members of the Legislature, it looks like we may have a chance to get to Senator Bourne's amendment, but we have to go through the people's tax to get there. And because the people's tax is there, then...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...I may go into consultation if somebody else is going to speak. But I wanted to ask Senator Brashear a question. Senator Brashear, what does LB 932 do, which is one of your amendments?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you respond, Senator Brashear?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: LB 932?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's the first one you have on the list that would come up.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Senator Chambers, it's something I learned from you. That's a placeholder.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, but when we get to that...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: It ha...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and you substitute,...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...what will the amendment do that you're substituting?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: The amendment that I am substituting will allow us to discuss the entirety of what I'm affectionately referring to as the "red plan."

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that would be the people's tax?
