SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the opening on Wehrbein amendment. Open for discussion. Seeing no discussion. Senator Wehrbein waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of AM3299 to LB 1310. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on adoption of AM3299 to LB 1310. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, of the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Amendment was adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman, for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. I move the advancement of LB 1310 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion is to advance LB 1310 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.
