CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you. Yes, Senator Wehrbein, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Madam President, could I have that read in reverse order, please?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, you may. Thank you. The house is under call. Will all members please return to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Chambers, would you please check in. Thank you. Senators Cudaback, Baker and Cunningham, would you please return to the Chamber. The house is under call. There has been a request for a roll call vote in reverse order, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1198.) 30 ayes, 8 nays, Madam President, on the Pedersen amendment.
