FLOOR DEBATE

March 27, 2002 LB 1309

SENATOR SCHIMEK: All in favor of the house going under call, please vote yea; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The house is under call. Would all members please return to the chamber and check in. The house is under call. Senator Erdman, did you ask for a reverse order?

SENATOR ERDMAN: Regular.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Regular order. Thank you. Senator Bromm, would you check in, please? I think we're all here, Mr. Clerk. Please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1200-01.) 17 ayes, 19 nays, Madam President, on the amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The amendment is not adopted. We now go back to the bill. First of all, the call is raised. And we go back to debate on the main bill. Senator Erdman, for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Oh, I'm sorry. Thank you, Madam President. I move the advancement of LB 1309 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Quandahl. It's been a machine vote. Senator Wehrbein...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I'd like...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...would like to place the house under call.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: All those in favor of placing the house under call vote yea; all opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, to place the house under call.
