SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Madam Clerk, is there anything else filed to committee amendments?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek, as Chairperson of the Government, Military Affairs Committee, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments. She waives that opportunity. Question for the body is adoption of committee amendments to LB 1086. All in favor of those vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee amendments to LB 1086. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk. Excuse me, Senator Landis.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator...committee amendments. Excuse me, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schimek would move to amend. Senator, I have AM3166, but I have a note you'd like to withdraw that and offer AM3341. (Legislative Journal page 1203.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: No objection, so ordered. Senator Schimek, to open.
