March 27, 2002 LB 1086

SENATOR SUTTLE: Okay. I just was wondering about that, but I do like the idea and will support it. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Suttle. Senator Schimek, there are no further lights. Did you wish to close on your amendment? Senator Schimek waives that opportunity. The question for the body is adoption of AM3341 to LB 1086. All in favor of that amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the Schimek amendment, AM3341, to LB 1086. Voting on the Schimek amendment. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted? Voting on the Schimek amendment to LB 1086. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schimek's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Schimek amendment is adopted.
