SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. You've heard the opening on the Raikes amendment, AM3375. Mr. Clerk, amendment to the amendment.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend the Raikes amendment with FA1035.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open on amendment FA1035 to AM3375.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, I would withdraw FA1035 and FA1036.
