SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on AM2695. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. We're voting on the Jensen amendment to LB 1089. Have you all voted who care to? It's AM2695. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Jensen's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Jensen amendment was adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Open for discussion on advancement of the bill. Senator Landis, did you wish to close? It's been rather a complex bill. If you want to close you have that opportunity.

SENATOR LANDIS: No, I don't want to close. Let's just move the bill, yeah. Take a vote. Take a vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman, for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1089 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: A machine vote has been requested, and a record vote also. The question before the body is, shall LB 1089 be advanced to E & R Initial? E & R for engrossing, I'm sorry. I'm sorry. Voting on advancement of LB 1089, E & R for engrossing. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk. Record vote has been requested.
