FLOOR DEBATE

April 3, 2002 LB 1073A, 1310

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1073A by Senator Thompson, a bill to appropriate funds to implement LB 1073. Senator Thompson would move to indefinitely postpone the bill. (Legislative Journal page 1355.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Thompson, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR THOMPSON. Thank you, Mr. Speaker. LB 1073, as it was originally written, had a fund from the Firestone...Bridgestone Firestone settlement created that has been amended out of the bill, and so we don't need the A bill anymore so I would request that you vote to indefinitely postpone this bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate? Seeing none. Senator Thompson, she's recognized to close. She waives that opportunity. The question for the body is, shall LB 1073A be indefinitely postponed? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to indefinitely postpone the bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill is indefinitely postponed.

CLERK: Members, would you please take your seats in preparation of Final Reading?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Mr. Clerk, LB 1310E.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion with respect to LB 1310E, and that would be to dispense with the reading-at-large.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: First vote is to suspend the at-large reading. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with the at-large reading.
