And it's really southeast Nebraska that really benefits because there's going to be a commissioner coming from the various counties in that area in the future and there never has been in the past. Senator Vrtiska's district will benefit; Senator Wehrbein's district; all the Sarpy County legislators will benefit, their districts will benefit; Saunders County; Butler County; Senator Bromm's district; Senator Stuhr's district; Senator Coordsen's district; Senator Byars's district; all will have the opportunity to have a Game and Parks Commissioner. For those of you who are not in southeast Nebraska, not in Lincoln, not in Sarpy County, not in Omaha, if you look at it in terms of raw power and raw interest, there's no reason for you to vote for this. But if there was ever an opportunity to reach out because it's fair to do so, this is it. And so I would ask for your support also. Thank you. Senator Kristensen.
