SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted. We're back to the Beutler amendment. Senator Beutler, you're recognized to close on that amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER:      Senator Kristensen, members of the Legislature, the matter is settled. The...so what the amendment does now is to put those two persons on the advisory board and then to provide that no member of the Legislature shall serve on the board and I would put that issue to you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Beutler amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please vote if you care to. Record.

CLERK:      25 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Beutler amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Erdman, you're recognized for a motion to advance.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I move the advancement of LB 1236 to E & R for engrossing.
