CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Landis' amendment.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: The amendment is adopted. Any other amendments to the amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers, FA923, Senator, first of all.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I will withdraw all of the pending amendments that I have on this bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis would move to amend with AM3425. (Legislative Journal page 1246.)

SENATOR LANDIS: And, Mr. Clerk, that is AM3425, yes, exactly. It says that the 25-cent registration fee will run from January 1, 2003, to December 31, 2005. This was a suggestion I made to Senator Chambers because historically fees are one thing that he's been sensitive about, but the benefit here is largely individual, not to the general public but to those people who use this system and who use the...get their drivers' licenses and their...the driver license tags for their cars. So we've agreed to do this three-year sunset so that he can examine it and see what he thinks because, as we all know, he'll be here till the end of time. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Heard the opening on AM3425. Any discussion? See no lights. Senator Landis. Senator Landis waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM3425. All in favor vote aye, all opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Landis' amendment to the committee amendments.
