SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, you're recognized to open on that amendment to the bill.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is a technical amendment suggested by the Department of Natural Resources. It would go to Program...it would place the funding in Program 331 instead of Program 334. Program 334, understand it's mainly a litigation fund, and this would put it into an operating fund so this was recommended by the Department of Natural Resources. I would try to answer any questions, but I think it's pretty forthright and pretty insignificant.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the opening on AM3614 to LB 1003A. Open for discussion? Nobody wishing to speak, Senator Schrock, did you wish to close? He waives that opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of AM3614 offered by Senator Schrock to LB 1003A. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the amendment offered by Senator Schrock, AM3614 to LB 1003A. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment was adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of the bill itself, LB 1003A. Nobody wishing to speak to that bill, Senator Schrock, do you wish to close?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is the \$750,000 cash fund for the water task force study that would take 18 months. Briefly, \$150,000, leaking underground storage tank; \$250,000 Soil and Water Conservation Fund, and, hopefully, \$350,000 from the Environmental Trust Fund, and that will come at a later time.
