**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1085, with the emergency clause, pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record.

**CLERK:** (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1583.) 30 ayes, 17 nays, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** Bill does not gain the required constitutional two-thirds majority. The question now is, shall LB 1085 pass with the emergency clause stricken? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record.

**CLERK:** (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1583-1584.) 29 ayes, 19 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** LB 1085 passes. LB 1085AE.

**CLERK:** (Read LB 1085A on Final Reading.)

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1085A, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.
