CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 921, LB 994, LB 994A to Select File. I have amendments to be...well, first of all, I have motions with respect to LB 1085 and LB 1085A, those motions being that they become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor. They're offered by Senator Wickersham. Amendments to be printed: Senator Kristensen to LB 1062; Senator Connealy, LB 426; Senator Landis, LB 1139; Senator Beutler, LB 1185; Senator Wickersham, LB 989. I do have a new resolution, Mr. President, LR 460 by Senator Landis. That will be laid over and considered at another time. (Legislative Journal pages 1604-1616.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Mr. Speaker, you're recognized to address the body.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Mr. President, I would suggest that we pick up two other bills on that list, the Select File list, just that group of senator priority bills there that are clean and do those this evening, and the body has done quite a bit of difficult work today and last night was quite late for the Appropriations Committee and I think that it would be a...even though we talked about going late, I think it would probably be a wise thing to adjourn and I would move to do that after we get done doing those clean ones. The clean ones would be LB 488, LB 488A, LB 1033, and LB 1033A, so it's two bills with their accompanying A bills. The rest all have other items. And if we could do those at this time. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 488A (sic--LB 488), Senator Erdman, I do have Enrollment and Review amendments pending.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman, for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 488.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 488A (sic--LB 488). All in favor say aye.
