FLOOR DEBATE

April 11, 2002 LB 57, 123

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. It's withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 57 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 57 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1628-1629.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 57 passes. LB 123.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wehrbein would move to return LB 123 to Select File for specific amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. Speaker, members, I just want to call the body's attention, this also has a sales tax exemption. I will support the bill, but it's on drainage districts, county fair boards, so forth. It's a reduction in \$5,500, not a great amount, and \$5,600. Somebody else will pay the tax or may provide the revenue that this is a loss, just an educational factor. If there are other speakers, I'll withdraw upon...once again, if there is anyone else that would like to respond.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Anyone wishing to debate? I see none, Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I'll withdraw.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 123 on Final Reading.)
