SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the motion to return. Senator Landis, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR LANDIS: My little dog? (Laughter) Well, apparently, if we could just move my little dog over to Senator Janssen's bill, that would be fine with me. I'd be happy to have this happen. Senator Beutler was kind to let me use LB 814. If there's a better home here, I'd be happy to make use of that. I'd ask for the adoption of the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the motion to return to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill is returned. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have AM3675 in front of me, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Landis, you're recognized to open on the specific amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: I would ask for the adoption of the amendment that was just previously described. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Beutler.
