SENATOR DIERKS: I'd like a call of the house, and if we could take a roll call vote in reverse order, I'd like that.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: There has been a request for a call of the house. All of those in favor of going under call please vote yes; all opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The house is under call. Would all senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Senators Schrock, Brown, Landis, Cudaback, Erdman, Synowiecki, and Coordsen, would you please return to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senators Schrock, Cudaback, and Synowiecki, would you please return to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. We are all present. Yes, Senator Dierks, you requested a roll call vote. Did you request that in reverse order?

SENATOR DIERKS: Yes.
