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SENATOR CHAMBERS: But you don't know.

SENATOR FOLEY: ...between the two...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You don't know that it was 15, do you?

SENATOR FOLEY: Not without...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Were they of the kind that you're offering?

SENATOR FOLEY: Not without checking the record I wouldn't know the precise number.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: How many did I offer to strike individual sections from that bill? Do you know?

SENATOR FOLEY: Senator, I don't know. I'll admit that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, fire away.

SENATOR FOLEY: I don't know. But, anyway, when we were on both General File and Select File you offered a very specific amendment that would have removed some qualifying language contained in the bill regarding protection in utero, and the...and I pointed out when we were discussing that particular language that I offered the term "in utero" to provide a certain parameter on how far I was willing to go with that particular bill. And you were very critical of (inaudible).

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, because you were not honest enough to admit that you had brought a political bill. I kept asking you, is this a political bill? You would not answer. You chose not to answer.

SENATOR FOLEY: Well...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I said (inaudible).

SENATOR FOLEY: Well, I've got the transcript. I've got the transcript in front of me, Senator,...
