find a way to set up a...at least a...a program availability throughout the state. If they don't want to offer it in "County A", perhaps they can contract with "County B" who already has an established program, and...and approach it in some fashion like that. But we just did not feel we could...we could probably take...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BROMM: ...this step that Senator Coordsen is suggesting and get anything done in the way of progress to...to make some improvements in the program. I...I also...if...if the body felt they were going to go with this amendment, I...I would have...I want to discuss with Senator Coordsen what it would mean, the words "with the concurrence of the county board." Are we we saying you have to have the program, and you have to have it with concurrence of the county board, and what if...what if the county board, for some reason, doesn't concur? But that's...if we...if we proceed, I think we'll want to discuss that. But I want to at least answer Senator Coordsen on what my position was and what our feelings were on trying to bring this about in the long run, and why we're not doing it in the short run. I yield the rest of the time back to Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The time is gone. I'm sorry, Senator Bromm and Senator Coordsen. Thank you. You heard the opening on AM3561. Open for discussion. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm going to be somewhat difficult to get along with today. I think the level of hatred shown last night by this body is reprehensible. If I bring a bill, such as the one pending on Final Reading, dealing with the Governor's wife being allowed to travel using campaign funds, kill that and I don't care. If I have a death penalty before the body and it's voted down or in any manner defeated, I may not like it, but that is the way it goes. But when this body deliberately, and with malice and hatred, attacks an identifiable group of people and adopts the policy that discrimination is what this state stands for, I am outraged. I think it is inexcusable, it is disgusting, it is unworthy of a legislative body. But since the Legislature chose
