CLERK: 2 ayes, 31 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment was not adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman, for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1303 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Open for discussion on the motion. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is a bill that I've had the opportunity to use for my purposes. We did do some substantive work on it. There are a couple of other areas of a substantive nature that I would like to look at and discuss with Senator Bromm, if I think there might be some massaging that needs to do...be done but, I said it earlier and I'm going to repeat it now, my intent is not to stop this bill from advancing. And I have used it for a goodly amount of time, but in the process we did some things with the bill that needed doing. So there are one or two other things which I want to look at, and that's the only reason I'm going to try to stop us from getting a vote on it before we go. If I have to put a motion up there to return it to committee or to bracket it, then I will do that.
