two of them are Cash Funds appropriations and first one, as I mentioned, is to change to Program 33, for the record, in the Department of Health and Human Services. This corrective amendment will make the appropriations align with the intent of the Legislature and, once again, it does not impact the bottom line for General Funds. I don't know whether Senator Jensen, who signed on this amendment, has anything to say or not. I would offer him time. That, in essence, is what it is. All three are corrective issues, Mr. Speaker, and I would urge adoption of this amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Open for discussion on the amendment offered by Senator Wehrbein. Seeing nobody wishing to speak, Senator Wehrbein waives his opportunity to close. The question for the body is adoption of AM3755 to LB 1062A. All in favor of that amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Wehrbein amendment was adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
