SENATOR CUDABACK:      Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 1105. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK:      Senator Bromm, AM3451.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Senator Bromm, to open on your amendment, AM3451, to LB 1105.

SENATOR BROMM:      Like to withdraw that amendment, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      It is withdrawn.

CLERK:      Senator Bromm, AM3452.

SENATOR BROMM:      I would like to withdraw, Mr. Clerk, as well as the next one, which is AM3538, I believe.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      They are withdrawn.

CLERK:      Senator Bromm, AM3533. (Legislative Journal page 1412.)

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Senator Bromm, you wish to open on the amendment?

SENATOR BROMM:      Yes, I would like to take that amendment up. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      You may open.

SENATOR BROMM:      Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Colleagues, LB 1105, as you recall the primary contents of the bill, is the rewrite of the telecommunications statutes which has been worked on the last couple of years. When we...when we introduced that bill we introduced a trailer bill, LB 918, to take care of cleanups that we couldn't take care of in the original bill, plus the trailer bill had a couple of contents that I need to describe to you. This amendment, as far as the telecommunications aspect of it, provides that the commission may most certainly administratively fine telecommunication
