CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Landis' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: AM3481 has been adopted.

CLERK: Senator Landis would move to amend, AM3562. (Legislative Journal page 1445.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis, to open on AM3562 to LB 957.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this is a measure that was originally LB 900, which corrected an erroneous internal reference in the provisions of subsection 9530 of the Uniform Commercial Code. Bill Marienau came to me at...early in the session. He said, you know, there was a misreference, an internal reference that was wrong; here's the bill to change it. The Secretary of State needed to compile lien information regarding agricultural related statutory liens, and there was a...a mistake in citation. Currently, the statutes require the wrong liens. The federal liens and the state tax liens to be in the master lien list, and we need to make an appropriate adjustment. And so that bill was unanimously advanced by the committee. It now is an amendment. It changes and makes accurate the internal reference. It is urged upon us by the Secretary of State, and it will maintain our lien filing system accurately rather than inaccurately. I ask for the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the opening on AM3562. Open for discussion. Seeing no lights on, Senator Landis...he waives that opportunity. The question for us is adoption of AM3562 to LB 957. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. The motion before us is to adopt the Landis amendment, AM3562. Have
