SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning, our chaplain for the day is Senator Cap Dierks. Senator.

SENATOR DIERKS: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I call the fifty-ninth day of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature to order. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call. Record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Corrections this morning?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Cudaback, you're recognized to open on the corrections. (Laughter) Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, bills read on Final Reading last evening were presented to the Governor's Office at 9:40 p.m. (re: LB 1089, LB 488, LB 488A, LB 876, LB 876A, LB 1211, LB 1278), and I have a Reference report referring LR 464 and LR 465. SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We next move to Final Reading. Members, would you please take your seats for Final Reading? We are on Final Reading, members. Before we begin Final Reading this morning, I want to, while you're present in significant numbers, to give you some idea of what we're going to do tomorrow. We have a variety of legislative resolutions that aren't eligible for the last day that we'll have to take care of. We've got a couple of confirmation reports.
