to read on Final Reading. We'll take up any motions to override tomorrow, and then we'll begin the business of winding down the session with a variety of items that are necessary. I would believe that tomorrow is also a very good day since we're ending on Friday for people who want to spend some time with their staff, getting things ready for the interim. In the morning would be an excellent opportunity to do that. Also, the committee chairs have expressed a desire to get together tomorrow morning as well. So with that in mind, I think a one o'clock start tomorrow would be good. It would be a great opportunity for people to do things in the morning with their staffs, and Senator Cudaback likes to take them out for lunch, and things like that over the noon hour. But then also at nine o'clock tomorrow morning would be the committee chairs meeting that I think would be a brief, not a long extended meeting, but one we wanted to have the last time we met. So for your planning purposes, figure on a one o'clock start tomorrow afternoon. I would envision we would done by, you know, later in the afternoon. I don't expect to have a great deal of other activity, but there are a number of bills that are important and those will be dealt with as need be. With that, Mr. Clerk, we move to LB 642.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Chambers would move to return the bill for a specific amendment, FA1112. (Legislative Journal page 1764.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President and members of the Legislature, when I get slapped around, you know that I have to counterattack. But this is not really in the nature of what I did yesterday because I'm not going to take all day. I'm not going to deal with every bill unless I get further provoked, and I've got something cooked up on my own bill, LB 1086, so after I get through working with that, if somebody wants to kill it, they're welcome to do so and help put me in my place for the session. And I will cheerfully accept that decision by the body. My motion is to return this bill, and this is the amendment that I would offer. And I'm reading it because I want
