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Cash Fund. But the fundamental idea that if we're going to pass a primary bill and it...and an agency that has to administer that bill is going to incur costs that we would somehow deny the costs that they have advised us will be incurred and that our Fiscal Office has concurred with, the fact...to suggest that we would not pass an A bill...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: ...is inappropriate. With that, thank you, Senator Erdman, for yielding your time.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Byars.

SENATOR BYARS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I've certainly been a strong supporter of LB 1033 and, as a matter of fact, encouraged Senator Erdman to make this his priority bill because I think it's extremely important for rural Nebraska in particular, and I think the concept in the bill is one that's very good and one that is encouraging of utilizing the resources that we have in the state of Nebraska in the best way possible. There certainly is a difference of opinion on that. But I do rise, Senator Wickersham, because I don't think it makes any difference there's \$1,100,000 left in the Health Care Cash Fund. It's the fact that all of a sudden people are starting to feel comfortable, comfortable with raiding this fund on a continuous basis. And we passed that two days ago and, if you'll note, the only red light on that A bill was Senator Byars, and I think probably the only reason I was the only red light is because nobody caught it ahead of time. Nobody told us that we were going to start raiding this Cash Fund again. Could it be an appropriate expenditure? Yes. Was it done, was this done in an appropriate manner? No, not as far as I'm concerned. Those of us on the Health Committee and on the Appropriations Committee that have come together to take these funds and utilize them in the way that we feel is the best use for the people of the state of Nebraska should be extremely offended, and I am. It has nothing to do with \$1 million being left. You might note also, Senator Wickersham, the other item at the end of that sheet is that \$11.5 million have already been taken out of that fund to balance the budget this year, \$11.5 million, which dollars that
