22 provisions relating to district court judicial districts, posttrial  
23 motions, execution of judgments, appeal bonds, forcible entry and  
24 detainer actions, in forma pauperis proceedings, presentence  
25 reports and psychiatric examinations, domestic relations actions,  
26 filing of pleadings and pleading nomenclature for certain actions,  
27 and the Counsel for Discipline of the Nebraska Supreme Court; to  
28 provide an exemption from execution for earned income tax credit  
29 refunds; to provide immunity from liability relating to the  
30 handling of anhydrous ammonia; to harmonize provisions; to provide  
31 a duty for the Revisor of Statutes; to provide operative dates; to  
32 repeal the original sections; to outright repeal sections 42-119,  
33 42-120, and 42-354, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; and to  
34 declare an emergency."
