

16 Sec. 4. (1) Application for a permit to carry a
17 concealed handgun shall be made in person at the office of the
18 sheriff of the county in which the applicant resides. The
19 application shall be made on a form prescribed by the
20 Superintendent of Law Enforcement and Public Safety. The
21 application shall include space for the applicant to affirm that he
22 or she meets the requirements set forth in subsection (2) of
23 section 6 of this act. The application shall state the applicant's
24 full name, social security number, address, date of birth, a
25 statement that the applicant meets the requirements of section 6 of
26 this act, a statement that the information on the application is
27 true and correct, a statement that the applicant understands the
1 use of lawful force for the protection of himself or herself, his
2 or her family, and his or her property and the applicant's
3 signature. The applicant shall present a current Nebraska motor
4 vehicle operator's license, state identification card, or military
5 identification card. The applicant shall also submit two legible
6 sets of fingerprints to the Nebraska State Patrol for a national
7 criminal history record information check pursuant to section 6 of
8 this act through the Federal Bureau of Investigation. An applicant
9 shall be twenty-one years of age or older and not prohibited from
10 purchasing or possessing a handgun by 18 U.S.C. 922, as such
11 section existed on January 1, 2002. An applicant shall possess the
12 same powers of eyesight as required under section 60-4,118 for a
13 Class 0 operator's license. When an applicant does not possess a
14 current Nebraska motor vehicle operator's license, he or she shall
15 demonstrate such powers of eyesight at the office of the county
16 sheriff when applying for a permit to carry a concealed handgun.
17 (2) No person applying for a permit to carry a concealed
18 handgun shall give false information or offer false evidence of his
19 or her identity. A violation of this subsection is a Class IV
20 felony.
