Summary of purpose and/or changes:

No person will engage in lobbying activities as a registered lobbyist until at least one year has elapsed after the date such person ceases to be Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, State Treasurer, Auditor of Public Accounts or a member of the Legislature.

This provision does not apply to lobbyists registered on the effective date of this act.
