A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section
2 28-813.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3 change the penalty for possession of child pornography;
4 to repeal the original section; and to declare an
5 emergency.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-813.01, Reissue Revised Statutes
2 of Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 28-813.01. (1) It shall be unlawful for a person to
4 knowingly possess any visual depiction of sexually explicit
5 conduct, as defined in section 28-1463.02, which has a minor as one
6 of its participants or portrayed observers.

7 (2) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty
8 of a Class ~~II misdemeanor~~ IV felony.

9 Sec. 2. Original section 28-813.01, Reissue Revised
10 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.

11 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
12 when passed and approved according to law.
