A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to liquor law; to amend section 53-169.01,
2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to eliminate a beer
3 exception; to remove obsolete language; and to repeal the
4 original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 53-169.01, Reissue Revised Statutes
2 of Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 53-169.01. No manufacturer of alcoholic liquor holding a
4 manufacturer's license under section 53-123.01 and no manufacturer
5 of alcoholic liquor outside this state manufacturing alcoholic
6 liquor, ~~except beer,~~ for distribution and sale within this state
7 shall, directly or indirectly, as owner or part owner, or through a
8 subsidiary or affiliate, or by any officer, director, or employee
9 thereof, or by stock ownership, interlocking directors,
10 trusteeship, loan, mortgage, or lien on any personal or real
11 property, or as guarantor, endorser, or surety, be interested in
12 the ownership, conduct, operation, or management of any alcoholic
13 liquor wholesaler holding an alcoholic liquor wholesale license. ~~14 except beer, under section 53-123.02.~~

15 No manufacturer of alcoholic liquor holding a
16 manufacturer's license under section 53-123.01 and no manufacturer
17 of alcoholic liquor outside this state manufacturing alcoholic
18 liquor, ~~except beer,~~ for distribution and sale within this state
19 shall be interested directly or indirectly, as lessor or lessee, as
20 owner or part owner, or through a subsidiary or affiliate, or by
21 any officer, director, or employee thereof, or by stock ownership,
22 interlocking directors, or trusteeship in the premises upon which
23 the place of business of an alcoholic liquor wholesaler holding an
24 alcoholic liquor wholesale license, ~~except beer, under section
25 53-123.02~~ is located, established, conducted, or operated in whole
26 or in part. ~~unless such interest was acquired or became effective
27 prior to April 17, 1947.~~
