A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to crimes; to amend sections 28-451 and 28-452,
2 Revised Statutes Supplement, 2002; to change provisions
3 relating to the possession of anhydrous ammonia,
4 ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, or phenylpropanolamine; and
5 to repeal the original sections.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-451, Revised Statutes Supplement,
2 2002, is amended to read:

3 28-451. No person shall possess anhydrous ammonia with
4 the intent to manufacture methamphetamine or to use the product as
5 a precursor or an intermediary to a dangerous substance. Any
6 person who violates this section is guilty of a Class IV felony.

7 Sec. 2. Section 28-452, Revised Statutes Supplement,
8 2002, is amended to read:

9 28-452. No person shall possess ephedrine,
10 pseudoephedrine, or phenylpropanolamine, or their salts, isomers,
11 or salts of isomers, with the intent to manufacture methamphetamine
12 or to use the product as a precursor or an intermediary to a
13 dangerous substance. Any person who violates this section is
14 guilty of a Class IV felony.

15 Sec. 3. Original sections 28-451 and 28-452, Revised
16 Statutes Supplement, 2002, are repealed.
